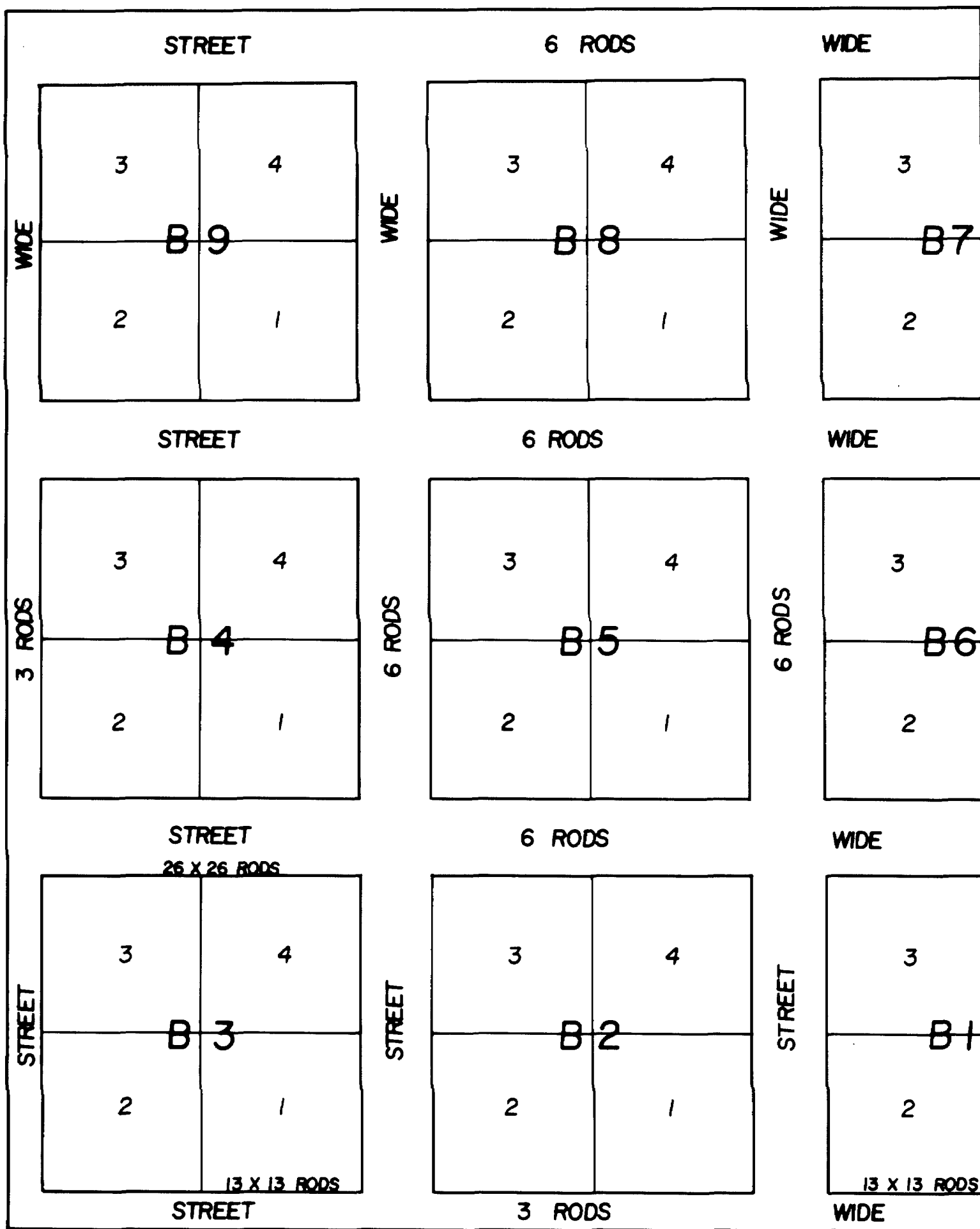


# CLAWSON TOWNSITE PLAT "A"

Know all men by these present that we William H. Hitchcock and Julia E. Hitchcock, husband and wife, of Clawson, Emery County, State of Utah, hereby certify and declare that we are the sole owners of the land embraced in the plat hereunto attached to-wit; the plat "A" of Clawson Townsite Survey; that said land being described as follows;

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 26 Tp.19S of R7E of S. L. Meridian, running thence North 100 rods; thence West 80 rods; thence South 100 rods; thence East 80 rods to place of beginning, containing 50 acres;

That the scale upon which this plat is drawn is ten rods to one inch; that the streets on said plat are six rods wide excepting the street on the South side and the street on the West side of said plat which are three rods wide; that the said lots on said plat are 13 by 13 rods and contains 1 and 9/160 acres each.

That the said streets are hereby set apart and dedicated to the public forever; and the said plat is hereby denominated "Clawson Townsite Survey Plat A" Emery County, Utah.
