## ADULT SOFTBALL RULES

- In-field fly rule is in effect.
- 3 Home runs per game
- Every one after is an out.
- Games are 7 innings or 50 minutes.
- If an inning ends at 49 minutes, teams will be allowed to play 1 more inning.
- Umpire can extend time if slow play is on purpose.
- Rosters must be turned in by July 29th.
- Each player can only be on 1 roster.
- Players must play in at least 4 games to be able to participate in the tournament.
- If a team has less than 8 players at game time it will go down as a forfeit. At that time they may pick up another player and play the game.
- If a team plays with 8 players, the $9^{\text {th }}$ spot will be an out.
- Teams will have 5 minutes after game time to get their $8^{\text {th }}$ player before it will go down as a forfeit.
- Both teams are encouraged to keep their own book. If there are any disputes the home team book will be the official book.
- If games go into extra innings, waiting teams must be warm and ready to play as soon as previous game ends.
- If ejected:
- 1 offense - $\$ 10$ fine
- 2 offense - $\mathbf{\$ 2 5}$ fine
- $\mathbf{3}$ offense - $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$ fine and done for season. Must also meet with board to be allowed back in.
- F Word is automatic ejection.
- Physical contact with umpire = Done for the year and the following year.
- Plays at any base - Runner must slide or try to avoid the tag. Bulldozing will result in an ejection.
- Start with 1 and 1 count.
- 2 Pinch runner per inning
- The pinch runner will be the person who got out last on your team.
- No metal cleats - $\mathbf{1}$ out will be assessed to the team if they have metal cleats.
- If you are caught with metal cleats twice it will be an automatic ejection.
- Pitchers are encouraged to wear provided masks.
- Legal pitches must reach between $6 \mathbf{- 1 0}$ feet in height.
- The batter will start with a 1 and 1 count, if the batter fouls off the first pitch he/she is not out, the next foul ball will be an out. If the batter already has 2 strikes the next foul ball is not an out, the following foul ball is an out. (Regardless of count the batter is out after 2nd foul ball).
No alcohol or drugs will be permitted nor tolerated on the playing field.
